ADDENDUM

Subject:- Grant of Compensatory(city) and House Rent Allowances.
.....

Insert the following as a new para below para 4(b) (x) of this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.2(37)-EII(B)/64 dated the 27th November, 1965:-

" A Government servant during the period of transfers not exceeding 90 days shall be entitled to Compensatory (city) and house rent allowances at the same rates which he was in receipt of at the time of transfer. For transfers exceeding 90 days, the grant of these allowances shall be regulated with reference to his new headquarters".

2. These orders would take effect from the date of issue. Past cases, otherwise decided, need not be re-opened.

3. In so far ^{as} persons serving in Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders issue in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General.
